That on the 14th day of December, 1962, pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law, more particularly Division 12 of the Water Code and Section 30321 thereof, there was filed in this office a Certificate of V. Dennis Wardle, County Clerk of the County of San Bernardino, stating that the formation of the district hereinafter named was approved by the voters at an election duly called and held on the 27th day of November, 1962.


I further certify that attached to said Certificate is a certified copy of the Resolution adopted December 10, 1962 by the Board of Supervisors of said County setting forth that the formation of the district was approved by a vote of 176 to 173, containing a description of the boundaries, and naming Harold H. Brown, Norman J. Essig, Norman W. Granger, Lou Holland and A. E. "Art" Miller elected as the first Board of Directors.

Therefore, I further certify that a County Water District situated in the County of San Bernardino, has been duly incorporated according to the laws of the State of California and is in legal existence under the name:
