To Whom It May Concern,

You are receiving this letter as you are listed as an “Interested Contractor” for Hi-Desert Water District (the “District”) Wastewater Reclamation Project (the “Project”) private property connections. Please read this notice in full to avoid fines and fees associated with private property connections.

The District’s Board of Directors (the “Board”) has adopted Ordinance 87 (the “Ordinance”). This Ordinance has established the District’s policy relating to the provision of wastewater services and facilities as well as regulations of those services and facilities.

Section 8.15.150 of the Ordinance (New Connections to the System) outlines the conditions under which and the process by which a property owner must connect to the system. More specifically, the Ordinance states, “No person shall connect to the District wastewater facilities prior to the date states in a written notice from the District to the property owner.”

Once the property owner has obtained all required permits and inspections required by the District and the Town of Yucca Valley (the “Town”), the contractor may make the private property connection. Property owners are prohibited from connecting without the required permits and inspections. Completing a prohibited connection may results in fines from the District.

Should domestic effluent enter the District’s system before the required permits and inspections are obtained, the contractor is responsible for notifying the District immediately at (760) 469-9780. The contractor may incur fees associated with clean-up of the prohibited connection.

Section 8.15.020 of the Ordinance (General Sewer Use Requirements) outlines specific pollutants and substances, including septic tank or cesspool drainage or pumpage, which Users are prohibited from discharging into the District’s system. Discharging prohibited pollutants into the District’s System may result in fines. The contractor is responsible for notifying the District’s immediately at (760) 469-9780 of any accidental releases/overflows. The contractor may incur fees associated with clean-up of accidental releases/overflows.
